Want to call SA home?

As an international student in South Australia, you will already be familiar with everything the State has to offer. But have you considered living here permanently?

As the State Government agency responsible for international migration to South Australia, Immigration SA offers pathways to permanent residency for skilled migrants, like you.

We work with the Department of Home Affairs to attract eligible skilled migrants to South Australia through state nominated visa programs.

If you've graduated in South Australia, state nomination may help you to qualify for a General Skilled Migration Visa.

As an international graduate of South Australia, you will benefit from:

- Access to a more extensive occupation list.
- Additional points towards the Federal points test for the 190-Skilled Nominated visa and the 489-Skilled Regional Visa.
- More flexible state nomination requirements for international graduates of South Australia.
- Priority application processing with the Department of Home Affairs.



How to apply



1 Visit homeaffairs.gov.au and migration.sa.gov.au/skilled-migrants/nomination-process to make sure you meet the federal and state nomination eligibility requirements for a 190-Skilled Nominated Visa or a 489-Skilled Regional Provisional Visa.



2 Find the contact details of your relevant skills assessing authority at homeaffairs.gov.au and apply directly to that authority for your skills assessment.



3 Lodge an expression of interest (EOI) at homeaffairs.gov.au/Trav/Work/Skil and choose South Australia as your preferred migration state.



4 Lodge a state nomination application at migration.sa.gov.au. If you are successful, you will receive a visa invitation from the Department of Home Affairs.



5 Apply for your visa with the Department of Home Affairs. at homeaffairs.gov.au
