# You could make SA home.

As a student in South Australia you will already be familiar with everything the state has to offer. But have you considered living here permanently?

As the State Government agency responsible for international migration to South Australia, Immigration SA offers pathways to permanent residency for skilled migrants, like you. We work with the Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP) to attract eligible skilled migrants to South Australia through state nominated visa programs.

By applying for state nomination as an international graduate of South Australia, you will benefit from:

- Access to a more extensive occupation list.
- Additional points towards the Federal points test for the 190-Skilled Nominated visa and the 489-Skilled Regional visa.
- More flexible state nomination requirements for international graduates of South Australia.
- Priority application processing with the DIBP.

## How to apply.

Visit [border.gov.au](https://border.gov.au) and [migration.sa.gov.au/skilled-migrants/nomination-process](https://migration.sa.gov.au/skilled-migrants/nomination-process) to make sure you meet the federal and state nomination eligibility requirements for a 190-Skilled Nominated visa or a 489-Skilled Regional provisional visa.

Lodge an expression of interest (EOI) at [border.gov.au/Trav/Work/Skil](https://border.gov.au/Trav/Work/Skil) and choose South Australia as your preferred migration state.

Lodge a state nomination application at [migration.sa.gov.au](https://migration.sa.gov.au). If you're granted state nomination you will receive a visa invitation from the Department of Immigration and Border Protection (DIBP).
